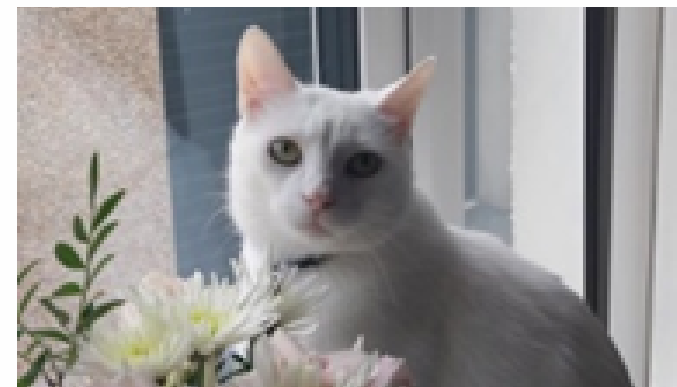
BLUE MONDAY
